

Safety Measures at Theatrikos

Steps You'll Take at the Theatre and Steps We've Taken Before You Arrive

Overview

We in the Theatrikos community are all eager to get back to doing theatre. However, it is essential that we do so in a safe and responsible manner to ensure the health, comfort,

and safety of our cast, crew and patrons. To that end, uniform compliance with the following safety protocols will be mandatory. We appreciate your partnership in safely keeping theatre alive at Theatrikos in these uncertain times. We understand that our policies may be more rigorous than the Arizona Department of Health and Safety requires, and may be more rigorous than other venues around the country. We believe this is the better, safer, more cautious approach.



Limited Audience Capacity

Theatrikos has blocked off our 75% of seats. Every other row is completely blocked off. Within the seated rows, patrons are seated a minimum of three seats (approximately 7.5 feet) between parties.



Physical Distancing

6' physical distancing must be observed by patrons, cast and crew. Separate line queues are marked for seating, Will Call and restrooms.

Face Masks

All patrons must wear a face covering the entire time they are at the theatre; including throughout the entire performance. This includes lobby and when



the restrooms. Face coverings must cover both the nose and mouth completely. (Per CDC guidelines, masks with exhaust valves or vents are unacceptable as they do not stop respiratory droplets when the wearer breathes out.) If a patron does not have an appropriate mask, a disposable mask will be provided to them. If you do not wish to wear a mask, we invite you to attend a performance next year.

Masking Actors

Actors are required to wear a mask during all rehearsals and even during performances are required to wear a mask when back stage. The only time an actor does not wear a mask is when they are on stage during the performance.



Lobby Furniture Removed

Lobby couches, benches, and chairs have been removed to prevent congregating.

Our lobby opens when seating begins and patrons go directly to their seats.

Actors 12' from the First Row

A taped line is placed across the stage 12 feet from the front row. Actors are prohibited from crossing this line during a performance. Directors will plan the actors' movements on stage accordingly.



Hand Sanitizer and Temperature Taken at Entrance

At the door, patrons' temperatures are taken and they are required to use hand sanitizer before

entering. Any person who presents obvious symptoms or a temperature of 99.5F or higher will be denied entry and asked to contact the box office for a ticket to a future show.

Touchless Online Digital Tickets

Patrons are encouraged to purchase their tickets online rather than picked up at Will Call when possible.





Distanced Queuing

Queuing marks are indicated 6 feet along a queue from the parking lot to the front door and within the lobby. Each group in line is always greeted by the Safety Coordinator and advised of the requirement to wear a mask while in the building.

Restrooms

Patrons wishing to use the restroom are encouraged to do so before being seated.





Programs


Show programs are laid out on a table for patrons to pick up at their leisure. No programs touched may be put back on the table.



Small Casts and Crew

To assure safe social distancing back stage, Theatrikos' Artistic Committee has intentionally selected

shows with smaller cast and crew. Ushering is limited to the Safety Coordinator and House Manager, or other qualified cast and crew trained by the Safety Coordinator.



Actor Dressing Stations

During performances, each actor is assigned their own dressing area separate from others and is required to maintain social distancing when not on stage.



Video Auditions

Auditions and some of the first rehearsals will take place over Zoom.

Intermission

Some shows do not have an intermission. If a show does have an intermission, patrons are asked to stay seated. If a patron needs to step outside or use the restroom during an intermission, they must raise their hand and ask the Safety Coordinator or House Manager to assist safe conveyance.



Increased Sanitation

All touched surfaces in the lobby, in the house and on the stage are thoroughly cleaned and sanitized prior to and after every performance, executing a checklist to ensure that nothing is missed. Sinks and toilets in the restrooms are sanitized after each performance.

Closed Concessions

The concessions booth is closed until further notice. This allows patrons to wear their mask throughout their entire time in the theatre.

During Performances

The Safety Coordinator and House Manager check the audience during the performance to ensure they are following guidelines and offer assistance as needed. Failure to comply may result in the patron being asked to leave the theatre. The Safety Coordinator shall have the authority to pause the performance if necessary, to ensure compliance.



Organized Exit Plan

At the end of the performance, the audience will remain seated. The Safety Coordinator will then dismiss one group at a time based on proximity to the exits. Patrons will keep their face covering on until they are out of the parking lot.

Covid 19 Testing

All cast and crew are required to take Covid 19 tests. They will take a test immediately prior to the start of rehearsal and again prior to the opening of the show.



Suspended Meet and Greet

Meet and greets between actors and patrons will be suspended until

restrictions are lifted for the health and safety of both the patrons and actors.

Safety in Daily Lives

All Cast and Crew are expected to maintain safest practices as outlined by the CDC in their daily lives. They will be required to report any potential exposure to the Stage Manager or Safety Coordinator.

Possible Cancelled Performances

Due to fluctuating health statistics, any performance of any show may be cancelled at the last minute. Patrons will be able to reschedule which performance they wish to attend or attend a streamed performance in place of an in-person performance.

Thank you for helping us keep you and our cast and crew safe while, on a limited basis, we slowly start to once again bring amazing theatre to our Northern Arizona home.
